B DOUBLE U TOPS 2ND SET OF HERITAGE QUALIFIERS

OKLAHOMA CITY--While the 12 races run Friday evening to determine five qualifiers for the rich Heritage Place Futurity G1 were definitely influenced by the wind that came from the south and then from the north, all was calm at Remington Park Saturday night when they ran another dozen trials to select the

final five qualifiers for the \$1,093,420 race that will be run at this Oklahoma City track on June 4.

B Double U, the PYC Paint Your Wagon gelding that won Saturday's first trial, emerged as the night's overall fastest qualifier after running 350 yards in :17.467 while winning that race by three-quarters of a length.

It was the first win in four starts for the \$39,000 earner who had run eighth in the Remington Park Futurity RG2 on April 16.

Bred and owned by Greg Cullum of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma, the gelding foaled February 11, 2014 is trained by Brian Muse and was ridden by Cody Jensen.

B Double U comes from the female family of all-time leading sire First Down Dash and all of those Stanley-bred runners. This is the same female family of Saturday's No. 4 qualifier V Power \$180,000, who is the nation's No. 4 earner thru Saturday night.

While the five Friday night qualifiers came from the 8th, 9th and 11th trials, all five of Saturday's qualifiers came from the first six trials.

The Equibase charts from Saturday night's 12 races showed no measurable wind for the entire evening.

OTHER NEWS

You can expect a big fight to begin this week in New Mexico. While an agenda for this Wednesday's meeting of the New Mexico Racing Commission has not been posted on that ruling body's website, that agenda supposedly is going to contain



a request from Sunland Park to drop the racing of American Quarter Horses beginning with the meet scheduled to open this December. The track just across the New Mexico border from El Paso has been running a mixed meet of Quarter Horses and Thoroughbreds since it opened in the late 1950s. This matter probably will not be settled this week . . . if ever.

Another big spring storm in the Houston area forced officials

at Sam Houston Race Park to call off Saturday night's racing. The card included the \$44,640 Adequan Texas Derby Challenge and the \$69,600 John Deere Texas Juvenile Challenge G3. Look for those two stakes to be added to Monday's card, which is the final program of the 2016 meet.



Seven trials for the Heritage Place Derby G2 are scheduled today at Remington Park. The first of the 400-yard trials is set for 2:22 p.m. CDT. Last year's Heritage Place Futurity G1 winner BV Midnite Express \$796,023 is in the third trial (3:14 p.m.) with four other six figure earners. This is easily the nation's toughest set of derby trials to date in 2016.

And tonight at Los Alamitos at 9:46 p.m. PDT, they will run

the track's richest "early" futurity since 1987. The Kindergarten Futurity is now called the Robert Adair Kindergarten Futurity G2, and the \$428,400 purse is the



richest since 1987 when Runway Winner took the money. Oldtimers Ron Hartley and John Cooper will be trying to get the money with fastest qualifier One Proud Eagle.
